LogistiCare Wins Non-Emergency Transportation Contract for Kentucky

ATLANTA -- LogistiCare announced today that the commonwealth of Kentucky has awarded the company a five-year contract to manage non-emergency transportation (NET) for eligible Medicaid recipients in the greater-Louisville area, which includes the following counties: Bullitt, Jefferson (City of Louisville), Oldham, Shelby and Spencer.

LogistiCare will manage the complete NET transportation process for Medicaid recipients in the region, including eligibility screening, trip scheduling and third-party contracting with local transportation companies who will provide the actual trip service. LogistiCare also will handle provider reimbursement and overall quality assurance.

Called the Human Service Transportation Delivery program (HSTD), Medicaid NET In Kentucky is managed by the Office of Transportation Delivery. The contract runs through 2010.
