SERVICES DELIVERED

LogistiCare began operating in Mississippi in November 2006, under a statewide, three-year agreement with the Division of Medicaid to manage Non-emergency Medical Transportation (NET) for eligible Medicaid recipients. This contract represents the first ever fully capitated, statewide NET brokerage operation in Mississippi.

The Mississippi NET program is unique when compared to other state programs we serve, due to the devastating blow dealt to the area by Hurricane Katrina. Almost all of Mississippi's 82 counties were declared disaster areas and are still involved in the process of being rebuilt. During our implementation and now during our ongoing operation, we are paying special attention to the challenges of service delivery in the designated disaster areas.

Under this contract, LogistiCare's objective for Mississippi's NET program is to ensure that the transportation services are comprehensive, reliable, safe, cost-effective, and consistent throughout the state.

We have already begun to address some of the challenges faced by the state program in previous years. The increased use of public transportation combined with an expanded network of transportation providers that includes new, smaller, local operations, will help us to meet the new program standards.
