SERVICES DELIVERED

In July 2003, LogistiCare was awarded a two-year contract by the state of Nevada to implement and operate a statewide non-emergency medical transportation brokerage program. Nevada decided to convert to a statewide brokerage program after becoming concerned about the rising cost and inappropriate use of Medicaid non-emergency transportation services. Among the many abuses taking place were: ineligible riders, trips for non-covered Medicaid services, multiple trips where only one trip was necessary, providing an ambulance trip when not medically necessary, or billing for trips which never occurred.

This program is demonstrating LogistiCare's skills in building and strengthening provider networks. Initially, LogistiCare relied on the existing infrastructure, which consisted mostly of cabs, especially in the Las Vegas area. However, the nature of the tourism and convention business makes this source of transport unavailable at times. Therefore, we are working cooperatively with providers to develop networks specific to non-emergency transportation, such as the local African Methodist Episcopal Church (AME) and other local transportation providers. Nevada is also unique in that many areas of the state represent the most rural in LogistiCare's geographical footprint. As a result, this program features air transport more prominently than in other areas where the company conducts business.
