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## **LogistiCare Awarded Colorado Medicaid Transportation Management Contract**

**ATLANTA** – LogistiCare announced today that the state of Colorado Department of Health Care Policy and Financing has awarded the company a contract to continue management of the Medicaid Non-Emergent Medical Transportation (NEMT) program in eight counties, including Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, Jefferson, and Larimer. The contract will run through June 30, 2007, with four subsequent one-year renewal options.

LogistiCare has provided NEMT management services for the eight counties since Oct. 1, 2004, when the company was asked to take over the program on an emergency basis as the result of accounting issues and fiscal challenges the program was experiencing.
